



F-1 STEM OPT Extension Request

STEM OPT Extension Eligibility Requirements

Highlights

- F-1 students currently on a valid 12-Month Post-completion OPT with an eligible STEM degree have the option to apply for a 24-Month STEM OPT Extension to receive an additional 2 years of employment authorization that is directly related to their STEM degree program.
- You may apply for the STEM OPT extension up to 90 days before your 12-month post-completion OPT Employment Authorization Document expires. USCIS must receive the application before OPT expiration date.
- If your STEM OPT application is filed on time, you may work up to 180 days beyond the expiration date of your original OPT EAD while the STEM application is pending with USCIS.
- A student may not be authorized for more than two lifetime STEM OPT extensions.

Things to Remember

- Employment must be paid while on STEM OPT.
- You must work a minimum of 20 hours per week per employer.
- Applicants must be working for an E-verify employer while on STEM OPT. Please refer to the [E-Verify Employer Search Tool](#).
- The employer must be willing to complete the [I-983 Training Plan](#) with the applicant.
- You must obtain the I-20 with the STEM recommendation from the ISO prior to applying with USCIS.



List of required documents needed to apply for STEM OPT

Document checklist:

- **Completed I-765 form**
 - The form I-765 can be downloaded from <https://www.uscis.gov/i-765>. Click "Forms" in the bar at the top of the page. If applying online, the online application IS the I-765. Please refer to the [STEM OPT Online Guide](#).
 - STEM OPT--(c)(3)(C).
 - NOTE: You must file your Form I-765 within 60 days of the date that your DSO enters the recommendation for STEM OPT into your SEVIS record. If you fail to do so, USICS will deny your STEM OPT request.

- Completed [I-983 Training Plan \(I-983 Guide\)](#)
- Official Offer Letter on Company Letterhead
- All **previously issued I-20s** from TCU and prior schools, if applicable (copies)
- Copy of the front and back of your current OPT EAD card
- Copy of Diploma AND official transcript showing your graduation from an eligible STEM field
- Your most [recent I-94](#)
- Copy of your valid Passport
- F-1 visa stamp

VERY IMPORTANT

You must obtain a new I-20 with a STEM OPT recommendation from the ISO prior to filing with USCIS regardless if you are filing online or by mail. Applying to USCIS without the new I-20 containing the STEM OPT recommendation will result in a denial of your OPT application and the loss of your application fee.
